- My supervisor was BUSY ALL THE TIME . I was stressing and couldn't go further with my work because sometimes she didn't even answer me on skype, and I tried to tell the responsible there but the only answer I was given was that she had too much work.

While the other trainees had their supervisors with them all the time. I have told the Human Resources Manager about my disappointment and her answer was : "yes you are right but unfortunately this summer all the department had so much work to do. It was a lack of luck for you".
